The Proper Way to Use a Septic Tank

It is important to inspect it regularly

Make sure the toilet is thoroughly flushed every time you use it.

If there isn't enough water, the toilet will clog and the septic tank will lose its effectiveness. Make sure that when the toilet is used, it is flushed completely after.



Disinfect the discharged water.

It is necessary to disinfect the water discharged from the septic tank. Please regularly use disinfectants to do so. (Please ask maintenance workers for more details).



Do not use chemical products to clean your toilet.

Using strong chemicals and detergents will cause the microorganisms in the septic tank to die and the septic tank will stop working properly.

Only use toilet paper.

Do not put cigarette butts, feminine hygiene products, rubber or latex products or any other objects in the toilet.



Do not place any object on manholes.

This makes it difficult to conduct inspections, service calls and clean ups.



Do not unplug the unit.

If the unit is unplugged, the microorganisms inside the septic tank will die and the septic tank will stop working properly.
