

The Mie "Priority Parking" Tag System



This system regulates the distribution of special parking tags for persons who experience difficulty walking due to illness, disability, pregnancy, etc. These tags are necessary when using the priority parking spaces available at businesses, public institutions and other places around the Prefecture.

Eligible Individuals for Parking Tags

● Individuals who have difficulty walking and meet the following criteria are eligible:

※ Priority Parking Tags can also be used when eligible individuals ride as passengers in a vehicle.

How to use Priority Parking Tags

When parking in a priority parking space, please place your priority parking tag so that it is visible from the outside of your vehicle.
